1.7 MILLION VISITORS!

The Zoo Levy helps keep the Cincinnati Zoo affordable for everyone!

About **65%** of visitors come from outside the metro region

On average, for every **\$1** of tax levy funding the Zoo receives, it generates **\$10** in economic benefit with Hamilton County due to the spending of non-local visitors.





The Cincinnati Zoo has a significant and beneficial impact on the area, providing **\$170,000,000** annual economic impact to our region*, a 400% return on investment (generated via operating expenditures.)



LEVY FUNDS ONLY GO TO ONGOING, BASIC ZOO NEEDS:




